WHEREAS, launched by The Love Foundation, Inc. in 2004, Global Love Day is an annual observance of the power and strength of love, tolerance, peace and unity for our world; and

WHEREAS, all nations and all peoples share the universal bond and common heritage of love; and

WHEREAS, all life is interconnected and interdependent, and efforts to help others in times of need are evidence of our humanity; and

WHEREAS, compassion and kindness can change the very nature of our experiences and expand into our everyday activities in a positive way; and

WHEREAS, the diversity in our islands allows us opportunities to learn about different cultures, traditions and beliefs, to embrace others with respect and acceptance; and

WHEREAS, love for humanity and love for planet Earth means taking care of all that has been given to us—from our keiki to our kūpuna, from the land to the sea; and

WHEREAS, compassion, kindness, joy and peace come naturally when we recognize that love begins from within ourselves and our actions do make a difference;

THEREFORE I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the **State of Hawai'i,** do hereby proclaim May 1, 2020 as

"GLOBAL LOVE DAY"

in Hawai'i and ask the people of the Aloha State to join me in celebrating compassion, peace and unity; appreciate the many organizations and individuals who work to help their neighbors; recognize the importance of love, peace and aloha in our world that inspires and nurtures our communities; and make our home a safer and better place each day through the power of love.
